TCGP Application Process Overview, 2018

Stage 1: Submit an Online Application

Please submit your online application by 31st March 2018. It is advisable to apply early; should a high volume of applications be received then the application process will be closed earlier. You do not need to have a TEFL certification or to have finished your degree to make an application.

The online application form will request that you attach your CV/ resume. Do consider how to highlight your leadership, presentation and teaching related skills, to make your application stand out.

You will be contacted within 10 working days if your application has progressed to Stage 2, and a member of our team will email you proposing a range of times for your initial skype interview to take place.

Please note that due to the volume of applications received, we are unable to respond if your application has not been successful.

Stage 2: The Opportunity China Skype Interview

Shortlisted candidates will be invited to attend a skype interview, between November and April depending on when the application is received.

The 30 minute interview will be an opportunity to talk through your application, and to explain your motivations for wishing to join the Program. Your interviewer will be interested to learn why you think that you are a good candidate. We will also be assessing whether we feel you have excellent communication and presentation skills, a flexible attitude and the ability to thrive within, as well as enjoy, a very different culture.

Detailed advice will be provided on the full application and visa process. You will then be welcomed to ask us any questions, and provide details of any preferences you have regarding a placement location, or a placement with a friend/ partner.

Stage 3: 2018 Cohort Announced

The Teach China Graduate Program 2018 cohort will be announced by 15th April.

You will then complete the school-matching process and participate in a skype interview with your chosen school, during April or May.
